Registration fees

Abstracts

Both poster and brief oral presentations are welcomed. All participants interested in presenting at MACC-3 are invited to submit their work through the web-interface:

Abstracts are accepted without reviewing. Duration of an oral presentation is planned for approximately 30 minutes. The deadline for abstracts submission is 1 May 2009.

Abstract contents

Abstracts should be prepared in English, in electronic form as a single page. The following file formats are acceptable: Microsoft Word document (doc), Adobe Acrobat document (pdf), and black-and-white picture (wmf or compressed tiff, the later with resolution 300 dpi).

Abstracts should be formatted according to the following requirements:

- A4 paper format;
- 2 cm horizontal and vertical margins;
- affiliation of each author should be clearly indicated using lower-case letters in superscripts (^a, ^b, ^c etc.);
- presenting author name should be underlined.
- single-spaced text;
- 12pt Times-family font;

Location of the Symposium

Odesa is the third (by size) city of Ukraine with over 1 million citizens. It is situated on the Black Sea coast. Each year many thousands of tourists visit the city.



Odesa International Airport is served by major airline carriers including Aerosvit, Ukraine International, Austrian Airlines, El Al, and Turkish Airlines.
